05/07/10	HEYSHAM BARROWS To further target Heysham Barrows, where reports have been received relating to fire setting and underage drinking, on the National Trust site. Criminal damage and thefts at nearby properties and gardens have also been reported.	Operation BARNACLE was set up to target the area which involved a multi agency partnership. Regular patrols and checks of the area were conducted and any youths found congregating were either advised or dispersed using appropriate powers. The area was also placed on the 'Hotspot' for the ASB vehicle to check on a regular basis. The increased police presence has resulted in a significant reduction in anti-social behaviour calls to the police from local residents.
