PACT Meeting 06/06/11

The focus for the Neighbourhood Policing Team, (NPT), for June will continue to be the Barrows. Since the last PACT meeting in May nine incident logs were created, three by the NPT for alcohol confiscations, YRS's (Youth Referral Scheme), (8), and directions to leave, where the recipient is not permitted to return to a designated area for 48 hours. More importantly we have had no reported fires.

The National Trust have organised a meeting, which will be held in the Jubilee Institute, Main Street, Heysham on Monday 13th June commencing at 7:30pm. This will determine the viability of a Neighbourhood Watch / Open Space type watch being set up to assist in keeping the Barrows safe for the continued enjoyment of the Community and visitors alike.
