Fuel theft. A commercial vehicle parked at an industrial estate in Heysham, had its fuel siphoned from its tank. The offence occurred

between 20:00 29/01/2010 and 04:30 01/02/2010.

Burglary in a domestic dwelling. A vacant property on Heysham Road, currently up for sale, was targeted between 12/01/2010 and 01/02/2010. The offender/s gained access via a small wooden window frame at the rear of the property. After turning off the water supply they drained the hot water tank and removed it from its location. The offender/s left undetected via the front door of the property taking the water tank, a dehumidifier and the window frame.

Damage at livery stables. Unknown offender/s caused damage at a livery stables in Middleton between 02/02/10 and 03/02/10. Damage was reported to have been caused to fencing panels which affected the protected electric fencing.

Lock damage. Unknown offender/s put superglue in the front door lock at a property on Sycamore Gardens. The offence is reported to have occurred between 18:00 31/01/2010 and 08:00 03/02/2010.

A number of occurrences of Televisions being taken from caravans, at a leisure park in Heysham fit throughout February have been reported to the police. CSI have been requested to attend to establish whether any forensic evidence can be gathered.

The front offside window of a vehicle, parked on Montrose Crescent, Heysham, was damaged at 14:12 on 06/02/2010.

The outside pane of glass of a window at a property on Combermere Road, Heysham was damaged at 21:30 on 06/02/2010.

Between 11:30 06/02/10 and 11:50 07/02/10, a pane of glass on a front door at a property on Trumacar Lane, Heysham was damaged by unknown means.

Damage to a bus shelter on Rothessay Road, Heysham is reported to have occurred between 00:00 and 21:00 on 07/02/2010.

A garden fence on Curwen Ave, Heysham, is reported to have been damaged between 22:00 09/02/10 and 10:00 on 10/02/10.

Damage to a greenhouse, at a property on Main Street, Heysham, is reported to have occurred between 18:00 12/02/2010 and 08:00 13/02/2010.

An attempt was made between 12:00 13/02/10 and 13:00 14/02/2010, to take a mobility scooter

from an insecure shed on Warren Grove in Heysham. The offender/s failed as the vehicle had a flat battery.

Please secure any vehicles, cycles etc in sheds, garages and outbuildings with quality chains and padlocks.

Approximately 300 litres of diesel fuel was taken from a heavy goods vehicle parked at a depot on Middleton Road, Heysham at about 07:00 17/02/10.

Fuel thefts are on the increase – especially from commercial vehicles. Please report any suspicious activities seen around vehicles.

Between 18:00 20/02/2010 and 15:00 21/02/2010, both wing mirrors on a vehicle parked on Trumacar Lane were damaged.

Paintwork on a vehicle parked on Middleton Road, Heysham was damaged between 01:00 and 08:00 22/02/2010.

An attempt was made to burgle a property on Longlands Lane, Heysham during the hours of darkness. It is believed the offence occurred at 20:40 on 24/02/2010.

A juvenile was arrested at the scene of criminal damage on Rothessay Road, Heysham, by a Civil Nuclear Constabulary patrol in the early hours

of 27/02/2010. The matter will now be dealt with by Lancashire Constabulary.

A drunk and aggressive offender, who was witnessed causing criminal damage to a vehicle on Yewdale Avenue in Heysham, was arrested during the early hours of 27/02/2010.

Arrests have been made following a burglary at a business premises on Trumacar Lane, Heysham, between 22:00 26/02/2010 and 08:10 27/02/2010. A quantity of cigarettes, alcohol and a laptop computer were taken. CCTV and CSI evidence has been gathered.
